
Description of Fungal infections of vagina

Fungal infections of vagina, also called candidiasis, are caused by the yeast Candida albicans. The yeast naturally lives in the vagina but can multiply when conditions are right and cause the infection. The condition can cause inflammation, itching and a thick white vaginal discharge.

Fenticonazole:

Imidazole antifungal agent with a broad spectrum of antimycotic activity against dermatophytes and yeasts.

Fenticonazole shows unique multimodal action against Candida species involving:




Fenticonazole has also been shown to exhibit antibacterial action, with a spectrum of activity that includes bacteria commonly associated with superinfected fungal skin and vaginal infections, and antiparasitic action against the protozoan Trichomonas vaginalis.

Therefore, fenticonazole may be an ideal alternative to multi-agent treatment of mixed infections involving mycotic, bacterial, dermatophyte and/or Trichomonas spp.

Clinical Data


In randomized comparative clinical trial with clotrimazole, fenticonazole was documented to have better clinical and mycological cure rates with significantly longer disease-free interval rates at 4 weeks following single topical application of 600 mg ovule.

Clinical Data

Clinical efficacy of topical fenticonazole in Vulvovaginal Infections (VVI) cases was documented by Bukovsky. Trichomoniasis (100%); Candida (48.7%); and other (34.8%) pathogens were identified at baseline visit and following single dose administration patient responder rates were documented at 87% at the end of 7 days.



Clinical response rate on day 7 in symptomatic vulvovaginal infections cases


