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DESCRIPTION:


- » Itorihenz-50 contains Itopride Hydrochloride 50 mg tablets
- » Itorihenz-150 contains Itopride Hydrochloride 150 mg & available as a sustained release hard gelatin capsules.

INDICATIONS:

» In the treatment of patients suffering from Non-Ulcer Dyspepsia (NUD), Gastroesophageal Reflux Disease (GERD) and Functional Dyspepsia (FD).

MECHANISM OF ACTION:

» Itopride hydrochloride is a prokinetic agent. It has anticholinesterase (AChE) activity as well as dopamine D2 receptor antagonistic activity.



KEY FEATURES:

- » Approximately 50 percent greater improvement in symptom score than placebo.1
- » Good efficacy in terms of global patient's assessment, post prandial fullness & early satiety in the treatment of patient with FD.²
- » Itopride inhibits transient LES relaxations (TLESRs) without significantly affecting esophageal peristaltic function or LES pressure. ¹

DOSAGE:

- » The recommended dose of ITORIHENZ-50 is 1 tablets TID or as directed by the physician.
- » The recommended dose of ITORIHENZ-150 is 1 capsule once daily or as directed by the physician.

PRESENTATION:

- » Itorihenz-50 is available as a strip of 10 Tablets.
- » Itorihenz-150 is available as a strip of 10 Capsules.
